A Summer of Artistic Discovery

Seeing the World like an Artist

Keep this section for your records.

How do artists see the world? We will explore this question as we look at artists' depictions of the world and compare them with our own perceptions. Each week's theme is designed to engage children in age appropriate activities that encourage careful observation and foster children's creative interpretations of an aspect of the world using visual art, dance and movement, drama and music. As creative thinkers and artists, we'll go on excursions to explore local beaches, city streets, parks and our own school environment to notice the wonders of our world. Older children will learn about the lives of artists and visit galleries and studios to see their work and talk to them in person.

How Artists see Animals 6/20-6/24

Whimsical goldfish and comical flamingoes! From scientific illustration to Dr. Seuss' fantastical creatures, see how artists depict our furry and feathered friends. You will observe animals, move like animals and produce your own unique animal creations based on observation and a sprinkle of imagination!

How Artists See Fantasy 6/27-7/1

Have you ever chatted with a playful medieval dragon or ridden on a unicorn? In fantasy, all things are possible. Let your imagination be your guide as you bring your fantasy to life in art, music and drama.

How Artists See American Landscapes 7/5-7/8

American landscapes are varied, unique and ever evolving. Majestic mountains and waterfalls, skyscrapers and parking lots, farms and peaceful parks – the landscapes that surround us have a profound impact on our lives. Explore how artists use landscapes as a palette for stories, moods, and ideas.

How Artists see Feelings 7/11-7/15

Joy, Sadness, Fear and Love...how do you feel today? Artists show feelings in visual images, dance and drama. You'll experiment with color, symbols and movement to create masks and other creative pieces that express your emotions.

How Artists see People 7/18-7/22

A fascinating subject is...ourselves! Artists have always loved to paint portraits of themselves and others in images, words and drama. We'll become people watchers and learn the basic elements of figure drawing, photography and dramatic characterization to create our own portraits.

How Artists see the Elements 7/25-7/29

Earth, Air, Water and Fire! The four elements have many moods and forms. They support life, create the weather and sometimes unleash great destruction, providing endless inspiration for creative masterpieces.

How Artists see Cities 8/1-8/5

Hustle and Bustle! Artists depict buildings that shoot to the sky, vehicles that hum and honk, and commuters who wait and jostle onto buses. We'll visit busy city streets and notice the sharp angles, feel the buzz, and see the color in order to make our own artistic renditions of city life.

How Artists See Heroes 8/8-8/12

What makes a hero? Some heroes fight evil doers, some quietly help others and some right wrongs in our society. We will examine heroic qualities depicted by artists in paintings, legends and dramatic performances and consider how each one of us can be a hero in our own lives.
